Information to propose a paper

The call for papers of the congress **has been extended to 15th April 2022.**

There are 95 sessions and they are grouped into 8 Macrosessions with related scientific committees. In order to facilitate readability, each Macrosession is characterized by a color. The titles of the sessions are highlighted, and the complete text with the session coordinators opens by clicking on "show more".

In order to submit a proposal:

- select the session, the "submit a paper proposal for this session" message appears by scrolling the text to the bottom,
- clicking on the button will make available the "paper presentation format" to be filled in in which to insert the abstract. Enter all authors and contact person,
- **The length of abstract must be between 2,500 and 5,000 characters, including spaces.**
- The proposals might be sent in Italian or English.
- The format to be filled also includes a **short abstract** (maximum 500 characters, including spaces) which must be in the second language chosen.
- At the end of the procedure, you will receive an email informing that the submission has been received correctly.

The accepted proposals will be communicated **until 15th May 2022.**

It is possible to submit multiple proposals for different sessions, filling in the appropriate format each time, indicating the session in which another proposal was presented.

The session coordinators may request any additions and revisions of the abstracts. In this case, the revised abstracts must be uploaded **until 31st May 2022.**

All final abstracts will be made available in digital, downloadable and printable format to facilitate discussion during the congress. For this purpose, the abstracts will be collected in a volume (with ISBN) as a preliminary outcome of the Congress.

The abstracts are intended to confirm participation in the Congress where the topics will be presented and discussed. The full paper can be delivered **until 28th August 2022.**

The full paper will be uploaded according to the instructions. It must be arranged according to the Template and the editorial rules indicated. The maximum length of each full paper will be **25,000 characters, including spaces and notes.**

During the Congress the presentation of the paper can be made in Italian or English. The time available for each paper is approximately 15 minutes. More specific indications will be defined with the session coordinators.

The Congress will be followed by a publication of several volumes. The book *Adaptive Cities through The Post Pandemic lens. Ripensare tempi e sfide della città flessibile nella storia urbana. Times and Challenges in Urban History* is independent of Congress and does not constitute its Proceedings. It will contain all the full papers that will pass the peer review.

The speakers have the right to respect the deadline of 28 August for the full paper. However, only compliance with this deadline allows access to the publication. **Only the speakers who**

have sent the full paper before the Congress will be able to access the double peer review process and the revision for the publication of the full papers.

Templates and editorial rules can be downloaded from the site.

The session coordinators have the right, strongly recommended, to ask the speakers for an advanced version of the full paper with an **intermediate deadline (July 2022)** in order to be able to work on the introduction and preparation of the discussion. The scientific committee of the Macrosession will have a supervisory role.

After the Congress the speakers will have **until 15th December** to review paper and notes based on the observations and discussion of the session to send them for the peer review procedure.

The papers accepted after the double peer review procedure will be published in the book *Adaptive Cities through The Post-Pandemic lens. Ripensare tempi e sfide della città flessibile nella storia urbana. Times and Challenges in Urban History, Collana Insights, AISU International, Torino.*
