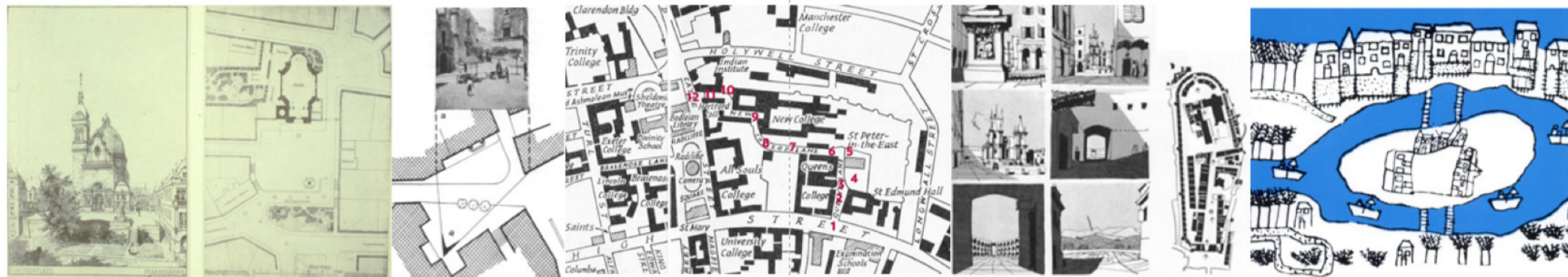

Heleni Porfyriou (Ph.D. in Planning History, UCL – UK) is an Urban historian with expertise in urban conservation and valorization. Senior researcher of the National Research Council of Italy-CNR (since 1999), is currently working at the Institute of Heritage Science – ISPC of the CNR <https://www.ispc.cnr.it/en/>. She was prof. of Town Planning History at the University of Rome “La Sapienza” (2000-2006), Head of the Rome unit of the CNR-Institute ICVBC (2006-2017), visiting scholar of Columbia University-NY (2018, 2022), and visiting professor of Peking and Xian Universities, in the context of the 7th European funded project “Planning, Urban Management and Heritage” (2012-2016). She has coordinated bilateral projects with the Chinese Academy of Cultural Heritage (2016-2022) and collaborated with WHITRAP-UNESCO <https://hul-bric.cnr.it/> and Xiamen University, since 2014 and 2019 respectively. In May 2020 she launched the global network Genealogy of Urban Design – GUDesign network, <https://gudesign.org/>. She published extensively on urban conservation, urban design, and enhancement policies in Europe and China.
